Re: Provincial Announcement for Move to Scenario 3 (at-home learning) for all grades K-12 on Friday, May 7

Dear Parents / Guardians of Lethbridge School Division

At 6:00 this evening, Premier Kenney announced some stronger measures as a response to COVID-19. The announcement applies province-wide with respect to measures in the sector of education.

Effective Friday, May 7 all students in Lethbridge School Division in grade K to 12 and all Early Education Programs will switch to At-Home Learning (Scenario 3). Schools will use Friday, May 7 for staff of EEP and Kindergarten to grade 6 students to prepare for at-home learning. At-home learning will commence fully on Monday, May 10th.

For grades 7 to 12 students who are already at home, learning will proceed on Friday as scheduled.

The province announced that students will be back to in-school learning on Tuesday, May 25th.
