604.3 Locally Developed Courses

- 1. The Associate Superintendent, Instructional Services, or designate shall assume responsibility for coordinating the development and approval of locally developed middle and senior high school courses.
- 2. The principal shall forward a description of each locally developed course to Instructional Services. The course description shall include all information specified in the Alberta Education policy, *Locally Developed/Acquired Middle and Senior High School Complementary Courses*.
 - 2.1. Descriptions of new Locally Developed Courses shall be submitted 3 months (excluding July and August) prior to the date course instruction is scheduled to commence.
- 3. Board approval must be obtained before the implementation of Locally Developed/Acquired Courses.
 - 3.1. Instruction shall not commence until Board approval has been received.
- 4. At the end of three years, the principal may submit a written request for reapproval in accordance with the timelines identified in regulation 2.1.
 - 4.1. Failure to obtain re-approval shall result in the course being cancelled at the end of the approved three year term.
- 5. The Associate Superintendent, Instructional Services or designate shall arrange for periodic monitoring and evaluation of Locally Developed/Acquired Courses offered in Division schools.
