604.4 Course Challenges

- 1. Course challenge assessments of this kind are intended principally for the placement of a student in a program route or stream and will not usually be approved for courses at the end of a program route or stream.
 - 1.1. Assessments which are initiated by the school, rather than the student, for the purpose of placement in a route or stream are not governed by this policy and its regulations.
- 2. Areas where course challenge assessments may be initiated by students:
 - 2.1. Grade 10 and 11 courses, whether or not the course is offered in the school.
 - 2.2. Grade 12 courses not offered in the school.
- 3. Responsibilities:
 - 3.1. The principal shall have the responsibility to:
 - 3.1.1. ensure that appropriate student-initiated course challenge assessment procedures are in place in the school;
 - 3.1.2. ensure that course challenge assessment procedures are outlined in the student information handbook;
 - 3.1.3. approve or reject all applications from students wishing to initiate course challenge assessments; and
 - 3.1.4. report the final standing of any student for whom a course challenge assessment has occurred to the student and to Alberta Education.
 - 3.2. The teaching staff shall have the responsibility to:
 - 3.2.1. conduct assigned course challenge assessments and report results to the principal; and
 - 3.2.2. ensure that the criteria and standards used for course challenge assessments are consistent with the expectations which exist for the course through regular classroom instruction.
 - 3.3. Students shall have the responsibility to:
 - 3.3.1. submit completed course challenge assessment applications by the date which have been set by the Division; (Form - 604.4.1 – App. Form – Student-Initiated Challenge Assessment)
 - 3.3.2. complete all course requirements which have been assigned to be submitted prior to the scheduled final examination and write the final examination at its scheduled time and date; and



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- 3.3.3. comply with course challenge assessment procedures as outlined by the school.
- 4. Applications and examination dates:
 - 4.1. The normal application dates for course challenges assessments shall be:
 - 4.1.1. December 1st, for an assessment to conclude in January.
 - 4.1.2. May 1st, for an assessment to conclude in June.
 - 4.2. Under special circumstances, the normal application dates may be waived by the principal.
 - 4.3. Under normal circumstances, final examinations shall be written during the scheduled school examination period at the end of each semester.
