LEARNING

Our Early Education Programs are child centred, play-based and developmentally appropriate, which provides for a rich early-learning environment for your child to have fun and to grow in.

The Early Education Programs are based on the most recent research on brain development and early learning in order to provide the best programming possible.

EXPERTISE

Programs are led by experienced early-childhood educators, supported by a team of skilled educational assistants, a Learning Support Teacher and Speech Language Pathologist, as well as an Early Childhood Co-ordinator. Spaces are set aside for children that may need developmental support, with the remaining spaces open to the public on a fee-paying basis.

DEVELOPMENT

Our programs provide engaging opportunities for language development, early literacy, early numeracy, social skills and more through play experiences. Staff are specially trained to support children with their speech and language development, and can support fine and gross motor skill development through daily activities. All children are met where they are at and responsively nurtured in their growth forward.
