SUMMARY OF HEALTH MEASURES

The Lethbridge School Division 2021-2022 Re-entry Plan contains health measures that place the safety and well-being of students and staff as a priority. Alberta Health mandatory and recommended health measures were reviewed. Additionally, the plan considered the local context and breadth of parent perspectives voiced to the Board prior to finalizing the plan. The plan is fluid and will change according to local context (COVID-19 conditions and stakeholder feedback), as well as Alberta Health and Alberta Education recommendations. On Sept. 15, 2021, the Government of Alberta announced new temporary health measures to help slow the spread of COVID-19. For schools, that included mandatory masking for students in grades 4 and up, plus staff and teachers in all grades

Masks

Students will be required to wear masks entering the school, leaving the school, and in common gathering spaces inside the school (e.g. hallways, washrooms). CLASSROOM PROTOCOLS: When students are out of their assigned seating plan engaged in close-contact interactive activities, they will be asked to wear a mask. When students are working independently in their assigned seating, they are permitted to remove masks. Wearing masks in outdoor spaces will not be required. Students will wear masks in mixed cohort groups at all times in middle school when students are combined from multiple groups.
