501.1 Attendance at School

Policy

Students shall attend school regularly and punctually as required by the Education Act and as mandated under the authority of the Board.

Regulations

- Except in the case of Independent students, parent/guardian are responsible for informing the school of their student's lates and absences.
- 2. Each school principal shall be responsible for establishing procedures with respect to:
 - 2.1. providing information regarding attendance requirements to students and parent/guardian;
 - 2.2. recording student attendance;
 - 2.3. determining whether an absence is excusable under the Education Act;
 - 2.4. determining whether absences or lates are excessive;
 - 2.5. informing parent/guardian when absences or lates become excessive;
 - 2.6. taking action to improve attendance or punctuality;
 - 2.7. accessing the Attendance Officer for further strategies to proactively improve student engagement.
- 3. The Superintendent or Administrative designate shall be responsible for:
 - 3.1. approving modified attendance requirements when appropriate for individual students:
 - 3.2. excusing students for extended periods of time if it has been determined that parents/guardians have shown sufficient cause as to why the student should be excused from attending school; and
 - 3.3. appointing one or more Attendance Officers.

The Board delegates to the Superintendent the authority to develop the procedures necessary to implement this policy.
