## 600.2 School-based Decision Making

## Policy

Principals shall work with <u>parents, teachers, school staff, parents/guardians, School</u> <u>Council</u>, and, when appropriate, students, and members of the community to make school-based decisions. <u>School-based D</u>decisions shall be consistent with <u>DistrictDivision</u> and provincial <u>policies</u>, goals<u>and</u>, priorities<u>-and decisions</u>.

## Regulations

- 1. All schools shall develop and implement a school-based decision making model. process with a focus on teaching and learning.
  - 1.1. The focus of the school based decision making model employed by each school shall be teaching and learning.
  - 1.2. The roles, responsibilities and relationships associated with the collaborative decision making process utilized in each school shall be defined by the principal in consultation with the staff and School Council.
- The principal shall provide opportunities for <u>stakeholders</u> the staff and <u>School</u> <u>Council</u> to be meaningfully <u>involved engaged</u> in school-based decisions on programs, budgets and procedures.
- 3.2. The District<u>Division</u> shall provide opportunities for schools to be meaningfully involved in District<u>Division</u> decisions on programs, budgets and policies.
- 4. The District<u>Division</u> budget shall allocate funds to schools in a manner that encourages school-based decision making.
- 5.3. The principal shall <u>support</u> ensure that appropriate professional learning opportunities are in place for staff and School Council members in connection with their roles and responsibilities in school-based decision making.

The Board delegates to the Superintendent the authority to develop the procedures necessary to implement this policy.
