### 501.3.1 School Choice

### **Policy**

Requests being made to attend a school outside of the designated attendance area is referred to as school choice. Fair and just consideration shall be made for requests by parents/guardians to have their child(ren) enrolled in a school outside of their attendance area in accordance with the regulations noted below.

### Regulations

- A student who resides in the attendance area for a school must be given priority over a student who does not reside in the attendance area.
- 2. Implementation of school choice shall normally be permitted between school years or semesters (high school), or when student programming requires.
  - 2.1. Admission to Early Childhood Services programs shall be in accordance with Division policy 501.2 Eligibility for Early Childhood Services.
- 3. Authority for approving admission of students from outside the school attendance area shall rest with the principal.
  - 3.1. Decisions shall be based on the following criteria:
    - 3.1.1. the capacity of resources;
    - 3.1.2. educational considerations, including suitability of school programs and services;
    - 3.1.3. projected enrolment for the school;
    - 3.1.4. the student's priority of enrolment (see regulation 4);
  - 3.2. After consultation with the Director of Inclusive Education, students with complex learning needs may access a program outside their attendance area.
  - 3.3. Decisions by the principal may be appealed per Policy and Procedure 505.9 Appeals Concerning Student Matters.

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## 501.3.1 School Choice, cont'd...

- 4. If school resources are near capacity, thereby limiting additional enrollment, students outside the attendance area will be given the following priority of enrolment:
  - 4.1. Division students with complex needs who can best be served in that school:
  - 4.2. Division students currently attending from outside school attendance area:
  - 4.3. Division students from outside the attendance area who have siblings attending that school;
  - 4.4. Division students from outside the attendance area whose family needs or arrangements merit consideration;
  - 4.5. Division students from outside the attendance area with none of the above considerations; and then
  - 4.6. students from outside the Division's catchment area.

Where applicant numbers in any priority area exceed the capacity of resources in a school, the applications will typically be approved on a first come, first served basis.

5. The Division shall not be responsible for transportation, or any costs associated with parents/guardians choosing to enroll their child(ren) in a school outside of their attendance area.

The Board delegates to the Superintendent the authority to develop the procedures necessary to implement this policy.
