600.2 School-based Decision Making

Policy

Principals shall work with their school staff, parents/guardians, School Council, and when appropriate, students, and members of the community to make school-based decisions. Decisions shall be consistent with Division and provincial procedures, goals and priorities.

Regulations

- 1. All schools shall develop and implement school-based decision making processes focusing on teaching and learning.
- 2. The principal shall support opportunities for stakeholders to be engaged in school-based decisions.
- 3. The principal shall support, and may identify, learning opportunities for staff and School Council members in connection with their roles and responsibilities in school-based decision making.

The Board delegates to the Superintendent the authority to develop the procedures necessary to implement this policy.
