WHAT'S INVOLVED WITH BEING ON THIS PANEL?

Our Inclusive Education Parent Advisory Panel consists of up to 8 parents/guardians and 3 representatives from school administration.

Panel members work with the Division to strengthen our Inclusive Education system by:

- serving in an advisory role to enhance understanding and consideration of procedures and perspectives,
- enhancing how the Division's Inclusive Education operational procedures and practices are implemented,
- providing valuable insights and feedback to Division leadership, and
- supporting the implementation of Alberta Education's Principles of Inclusive Education in classrooms.

PANEL MEMBERS WILL:

- serve a two-year term, committing to 5 meetings throughout the year,
- attend meetings in person during the day,

• provide feedback, through the parent/guardian perspective and lived experience, on inclusive education initiatives through the lens of Alberta Education's Principles of Inclusive Education

WHO CAN APPLY TO BE A PANEL MEMBER?

We are looking for a diverse group of parents/guardians, representing different Division levels (Early Childhood, Elementary, Middle School, and High School) and a range of student exceptionalities. Panel members should be committed to engaging in respectful, open discussions and representing the views of the parent/guardian community.
