SchoolMessenger:

SchoolMessenger is a powerful communication tool used by the Division and by our schools. For the Division, communication sent out via SchoolMessenger can include important details on things like Division programs, school bus route alerts and registration information. SchoolMessenger is also utilized to deliver alerts in emergency situations. Messages can be delivered via email, text and through the SchoolMessenger notification system. In your phone settings, please ensure you Allow Notifications for SchoolMessenger, to ensure you are receiving alerts.

MyBusStop:

Southland Transportation Ltd., utilizes an innovative app called MyBusStop. MyBusStop is a GPS tracking service, which delivers real-time information on a subscriber's bus location, route stops, route traffic, route schedule, route progress and possible bus delays. The app is responsive, as it provides seamless on-screen navigation, as users can zoom in, tap and scroll. Real-time updates are included, as users receive frequent bus updates, traffic conditions and dispatch comments. The clean interface highlights the most important information at your fingertips.

Microsoft 365:

Division students receive five free copies of Microsoft 365 apps, including Outlook, OneDrive, Word, Excel, PowerPoint and more. Parents, guardians and caregivers have access to these apps as well, and can download them by signing in to Microsoft 365 with their child's account. Please note, you will have to log in every 30 days to update your access to the apps. Elementary student accounts were reactivated on Friday, Aug. 29, and all elementary passwords will be reset to the student's Alberta Student Number number followed by their graduation year. Parents can request their student's passwords be changed to something unique at the school, and are encouraged to supervise students when using school accounts at home. Please note, over the summer, all student private TEAMs chats were erased. Moving forward, these chats will only be retained for one year.

SchoolGuide app (version 2):

Last year, the website provider for Lethbridge School Division, Rally, launched a new version of the SchoolGuide. With improved speed and reliability, SchoolGuide helps you stay connected with your child's school and receive important notifications and reminders.

Download the new version of SchoolGuide (version 2) from the App Store or Google Play today. If you have the old version of SchoolGuide (version 1) installed on your phone, please note it will not automatically update to the new version of the app. You must go to the App Store or Google Play to download the new app, after which you can delete SchoolGuide (version 1). SchoolGuide (version 1) will no longer receive notifications.

You can receive notifications through the app (in your phone settings, ensure Allow Notifications is turned on), scroll through news posts from your selected schools and view calendar updates to find upcoming school and Division events. Under QuickLinks, you will find direct links to powerful tools such as PowerSchool (where you can track your child's grades, assignments and schedules), SchoolCashOnline (where you can make payments online for a wide variety of items), Microsoft 365 (which includes valuable tools such as Teams and Flipgrid) and SchoolMessenger (a powerful communication tool used by schools and by the Division to relay valuable information). 
